Dear Mr. Laity,

At our September 2020 meeting, the NCAC voted to recommend to the Tillamook County Public Works Dept., in the interest of safety in our community, that Hawk Street from the Wayside to the Golf Course be closed to pedestrians and bicycles during the construction of the Neskowin Emergency Egress Route. The existing two track road is often underwater and is impassable to pedestrians and bicycles and remains gated throughout the year. The road is used for approximately 1-2 months during the summer when conditions allow. Hawk Drive and Breakers Boulevard are the primary pedestrian and bicycle routes in Neskowin and they provide sufficient capacity throughout the year. Mixing construction activities with the traveling public creates a safety issue that should be avoided at all costs.
